Château Cos Labory offers a singular interpretation of the Saint-Estèphe appellation and another expression of the hill of Cos. Once an integral part of Louis-Gaspard d'Estournel's original estate in the mid-nineteenth century, the estate grows its vines on slopes whose exposures contrast those of the prestigious vineyard of Cos d'Estournel.

Northern and western exposures, a geological diversity and prevailing winds forge wines suffused with the freshness of the nearby ocean. Each vintage is an expression of the nuances of these slopes. Plot selection and a minimalist approach to winemaking are carried out with a single goal in mind: the precision and balance of the blend.

Rather than delivering a formatted style, each vintage is a faithful expression of the grapes and the specificities of the terroir that yield them, with a strength and sincerity that reflect the temperament of the site on which they grow. Helmed by Michel Reybier and his family, Cos Labory is a testament to an ongoing commitment to bringing the appellation of Saint-Estèphe to its truest forms of expression.

Château Cos Labory 2025, Dazzling

The clay and gravel soils fared particularly well in 2025—an appanage of the most exceptional vintages—setting the scene for Château Cos Labory to begin **evolving its style**, particularly to include a greater proportion of **Cabernet Franc**.

Château Cos Labory 2025 is **enjoyable without being simplistic**, an extremely pure vintage with **dazzling fruit, a delight even when young**.
